

## Option B – Reflection

### God Loves You – A New Life With Jesus

**Main Reading:** John 3:1–21

#### 1. A Man Called Nicodemus

Nicodemus was a religious leader.  
He knew the Bible and the laws of God.

But he still had questions, so he came to Jesus.

- Why do you think Nicodemus wanted to talk to Jesus?
- Have you ever had questions about God or faith?
- Do you think it is good to ask questions about faith? Why?
- Who do you talk to when you want to learn about God?

#### 2. “You Must Be Born Again”

Jesus told Nicodemus that people must be **born again** to see the kingdom of God. This means God gives us **a new life inside**.

- What do you think Jesus meant by “born again”?
- Why do you think Nicodemus found this confusing?
- Do you think someone can know a lot about God but still not know Him personally?
- What is the difference between **religion** and **relationship with God**?

#### 3. God’s Kingdom

Jesus talked about the **kingdom of God**. Everything in this world will one day pass away, but God’s kingdom lasts forever.

- What things in life do people often trust in? (money, success, family, etc.)
- Do those things last forever?
- Why do you think Jesus said God’s kingdom is more important?
- What do you think it means to belong to God’s kingdom?

#### 4. Looking to Jesus

Jesus talked about a story from the Old Testament.  
People looked at the bronze snake and were healed.

Jesus said people must **look to Him and believe**.

- Why do you think God made healing so simple in that story?
- Why do people sometimes think they must “earn” God’s love?
- How do you think someone today “looks to Jesus”?

- What helps you trust Jesus?

## 5. The Love of God

John 3:16 says:

“God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son.”

- What does this verse tell us about God?
- What does it tell us about Jesus?
- What does it tell us about people?
- Why do you think this verse is so famous?

## 6. A Changed Life

When people are born again, their lives begin to change.

They may feel peace, joy, or a desire to follow God.

- What changes do you think might happen in someone’s life when they follow Jesus?
- Have you ever seen someone’s life change because of faith?
- What good things can come from following Jesus?
- What challenges might also come?

## 7. Prayer for Others

Cornelius shared that he became a Christian partly because **his parents prayed for him**.

- Do you think prayer can change people’s lives?
- Has anyone ever prayed for you?
- Is there someone you would like to pray for?
- Why do you think praying for others is important?

## 8. Personal Reflection

Take a quiet moment to think.

- What part of this story speaks to you the most?
- Do you believe God loves you personally?
- Would you like to know Jesus better?
- What is one step you could take this week to grow in faith?
